EFFECTIVE TEACHING

For the past two years I have been tasked with teaching six undergraduate courses and nine graduate courses. I have also been responsible for supervising student teachers in the past. I do my best to create an engaging and interactive online environment for my graduate students by providing weekly virtual meetings, creating group projects, and having students present projects via videos. For most of my courses I bring in guest speakers to give my students a different view of special education topics we are covering. Since I teach the majority of the Special Education programs, I believe having these guest speakers provides a different insight and additional information that will benefit my students.
